- Use advanced verb forms accurately
- Apply all conditional structures correctly
- Form and identify participle clauses in writing
- Use relative clauses to add detail and precision
- Improve clarity and cohesion in written and spoken English

Target Audience:

Learners who already understand basic grammar and want to improve accuracy, clarity, and correctness in writing and speaking.

SESSION 1 — Auxiliary Verbs & Verb Functions

Mini practice: identify correct verb functions in context

SESSION 2 — Active, Passive & Imperative Structures

Includes:

- Passive voice (advanced uses)
- Active vs passive transformations
- Imperatives in formal vs informal contexts

Mini practice: rewrite sentences in target structure

SESSION 3 — Perfect Forms in Advanced Use

Includes:

- Perfect tenses (active) — ONLY structure review, NOT tense teaching
- Perfect tenses (passive)
- Using perfect forms for emphasis & nuance

Mini practice: correction and rewriting

SESSION 4 — Modal Verbs & Meaning Precision

Includes:

- Modals for deduction, advice, obligation, speculation
- Phrasal verbs (introduction & usage clarity)
- Short answers

Mini practice: apply modals to real-life situations

SESSION 5 — Conditionals Part 1

Includes:

- Zero, First, Second, Third Conditionals
 - If-clauses
 - Conditional conjunctions
- Mini practice: choose correct conditional based on meaning
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SESSION 6 — Conditionals Part 2

Includes:

- Mixed conditionals
 - Inverted conditionals
 - Wish / If only
- Mini practice: expressive and hypothetical language tasks
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SESSION 7 — Clauses for Advanced Writing

Includes:

- Participle clauses
 - Relative clauses
 - Reduced clauses
- Mini practice: combine & reduce sentences
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SESSION 8 — Adjectives, Adverbs & Precision in Expression

Includes:

- Forming English adjectives
- Adjectives with suffixes
- Adjectives from nouns & verbs
- *-ed vs *-ing adjectives

- Country adjectives
 - Adjectives with prefixes
 - Adverbs (types & word order)
 - Changing pronouns
- Mini practice: editing for accuracy and academic tone
